What is the Showcase Cast?

- Showcase Cast is an audition-only advanced level musical theatre **CLASS** that meets every week for 2 hours for the duration of the semester on Thursday nights 6-8pm
- Monthly tuition (\$125) as well as a **production fee (\$135)** apply to all students cast in this show.
- If you have paid a \$120 production fee for a regular Shrek class, **the additional \$15 will be** made available on the Online Store along with a size selection **for the Showcase Cast t-shirt.**
- The Showcase Cast productions will be advertised to the public as <u>the very best Seedling</u> <u>Theatre Company has to offer.</u> We hope that participation in this group will become a goal for younger and less experienced students and will motivate them in their progress as a performer.
- This class dedicates 90% of class time on the final production. A higher level of commitment and maturity is expected from the members of this class/cast, as rehearsals often take patience, team work, and self discipline. Consistent attendance to class is required.

How is it different from the regular Teen and Jrs classes that are also doing Shrek?

The SHREK TEENS class (ages 11-18) and the SHREK JRs class (ages 8-11), will spend time on theatre education—stage directions, terminology, auditioning skills, acting techniques, etc. All students who register for the class will go through in-class auditions and are given a part in that class's production. Showcase Students should already be familiar with these theatre elements.

SHOWCASE TEENS students are expected to be **OFF BOOK** by the FIRST DAY OF CLASSES on Jan 7th SHOWCASE JRS students are expected to be **OFF BOOK** by TUESDAY, JAN 19

This means all lines and lyrics are memorized. This allows the Showcase Casts to get a head start on blocking and choreography for the semester.

Auditioning For a Showcase Cast-Shrek the Musical Spring 2021

- All auditions will be **submitted as videos** taken on a standard camera phone, without any sound edits
- You may submit audition videos for **up to 3 different characters**.
- For best results, chose a plain background like a bare wall. Film indoors, and reduce distracting noises
- Have someone else film you or set up the camera so that you don't have to hold it while performing.
- ALL MONOLOGUES AND SONG LYRICS MUST BE MEMORIZED
- If there is a song and/or monologue for your character, please do all parts (including multiple monologues) as indicated on the SHREK Slack channel and Audition Materials page of the website.
- Gingy and Farquaad auditions require a scene—have a family member or friend read for the other character
- All song segments must be performed with the INSTRUMENTAL TRACK provided on the SLACK channel ONLY. Please do not "sing-along" with the vocal track or use an alternate track from some other source. Do not alter the pitch or key of the instrumental track provided
- Please make separate videos of each monologue or song —files that are too long are difficult to send
- **Upload** the best versions of your auditions **using Direct Messaging on the Shrek SLACK channel**, sending Jrs Showcase Videos to Ms Maddie Watson and Mr Sean Evans. Send Showcase Teens videos to Ms Kris and Ms Kimbur. **OR** Upload your videos to **another platform like Google or YouTube** and provide the link to access them.
- All auditions MUST BE SENT BY NOV 14th—out of courtesy to the teachers and everyone else auditioning, **please do not wait until the last minute to do this.**
